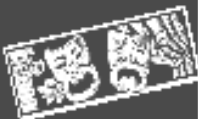
# SOUTHSIDE THEATRE GUILD

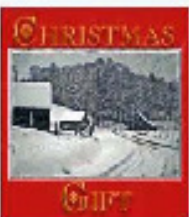
